

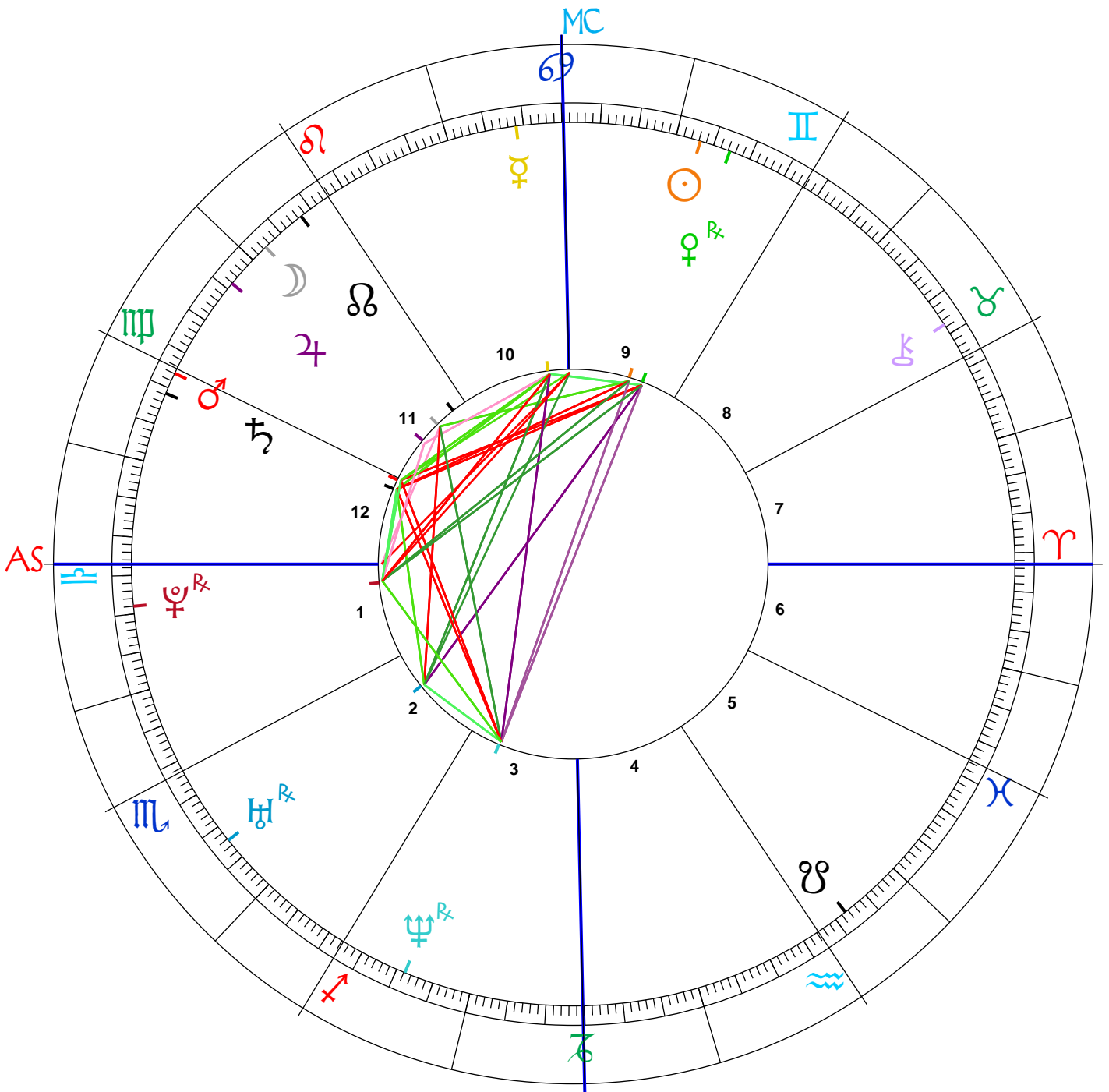

Venus' 'Young Life' Profile

Welcome to Venus' profile. It is written with the intent of giving concerned parties in general, an idea of Venus' character, talents, needs and wants. This knowledge will help point Venus in the right direction. This profile requires an accurate birth time. If you do not know the exact time of birth some of the information may not be completely relevant although the overall view will still be valid.

This profile is divided into a number of sections - detailed below - to make it easier to read and understand.

When reading this you will find both the positive and negative qualities of Venus defined. Most people will be happy to learn about the positive ones, while others may get upset over the negative ones. **Contradictions will always appear in a person.** They are what give us our uniqueness. We have tried to balance all qualities as much as possible so you get a good overview. Some children have wonderful charts while others have difficult charts and this will manifest in their personality.

The 'profile' as outlined here is not set in concrete and can be changed with your help. If the profile is positive you simply support and direct Venus. Where the profile indicates difficulties for Venus, guidance, direction and boundaries will be important.

Suitable for any young person from about sixteen months old and up. That is when she will start manifesting the qualities described. If you are having this profile prepared for a newly born child you will have to wait some time before it begins to make sense and be of value.

The 'Aspects' or individual characteristics are given a Star Rating from one to five to show their relative importance in the Profile. To the right of each pair of 'aspect' symbols is a group of five stars ★☆☆☆☆, the more dark stars there are the more important the connection. The keys for the planets and the other symbols and terms used are given at the back of the report.

Section A - laying down the foundations

1. Essential character - this profiles the general trends and outstanding characteristics of Venus 's nature, and also makes some comment on the quality of the relationship with the father. However this is not easily defined using Astrology so the section entitled 'Emotional and feeling nature' must be considered carefully together with this opening section.

* Between the first two sections, which deal essentially with father and mother there is a short section on 'The dominant parent'. We do not try to make a definitive judgement here but tradition states that the father is externally dominant and the mother is emotionally, or internally, dominant. Make your own judgement as to which parent fits the bill best.

2. Emotional and feeling nature - this shows how the more passive and sensitive side of Venus' nature is likely to develop and also comments on the nature of the relationship with her mother.

3. At this point we look more directly at the relationship between Venus and her mother.

4. Personality - this is a description of Venus' physical nature; and also her general approach to the world; the way she sees it; and the way she likes to be seen. For instance, does she wear rose-coloured glasses or does she view the world from behind dark glasses?

Section B - the process of development - from toddler to teenager

1. Assertiveness - this describes how Venus makes her presence felt and if she is essentially active or passive. Does she like to push her way to the front, or stay determinedly in the background?

2. Friendship and social attitudes - this looks at how Venus will get on with others. For instance, will she be a bit of a loner, have hundreds of friends, or just a few who are useful, and so on.

3. The power of the mind - this describes the approach Venus is likely to take towards the intellectual and academic side of her life and how she will respond to the rigours of education.

4. Money - this looks at how Venus will handle the money in her pocket or purse. Spendthrift or miser? Such traits establish themselves early and tend to remain with us all our lives.

Section C - preparing for independence

1. Higher education and establishing values - this section describes how Venus, approaching complete independence, lays down the belief and educational framework that will sustain her through her adult life.

2. Approach to daily working life - this looks at how Venus is likely to fare in the harsh world of work. What drive, if any, she has to succeed and how she will deal with the inevitable day-to-day necessities of work.

3. Career and ambitions - this final section examines how Venus might approach the business of how to make her mark on life, and what areas might be the most productive for her as she grows steadily older.

Section A - laying down the foundations

Essential character

The Sun signifies our inner sense of identity, and our will. It is the single most important planet in our birth chart and generally describes what we are seeking to become through the journey of life, or perhaps our 'destiny'.



Sun in Gemini

Versatile, bright and changeable, Venus will have a butterfly mentality and approach to life. She will stick at nothing for very long, for she lacks staying power and has an extremely low boredom threshold. Consequently, she will be always on the lookout for variety, stimulation and new experiences, and will try anything once.

She is likely to be highly intelligent. She may give the impression that she's only taking a superficial interest in what's going on, but her agile brain will have skimmed off all the salient points from the subject in hand and, to Venus, the salient points are all that matter. She hasn't got time for detail. Despite this, though, she is capable of displaying amazing insight, which may lead you to suspect you've been underestimating her all along!

Quick-witted and perceptive, she'll rarely give her full attention to anyone or anything. This is not to imply lack of interest on her part, however; it's simply that she is capable of thinking about several things at once.

She will want to know the answers to absolutely everything and will never stop asking the question "Why?" even if she lives to be 100. She will probably do well at school if she is given sufficient stimulation and her interest is captured.

When older, she will be well informed and a voracious devourer of newspapers and books. Physically, she will retain her youthful good looks well into old age. There's something of the eternal child about her.

Her restless lifestyle will ensure her metabolism is high, and will account for her slim, athletic build. She will rarely be found slumped on the sofa watching television, for she will find it difficult to relax. She'll have several projects on the go at the same time, and everything will be carried out at top speed: she'll talk faster, move more quickly and use her hands more than anyone else.

A Gemini in the family usually means a high telephone bill! Venus is a communicator, and never happier than when chatting, gossiping, or gathering and exchanging information. Her almost unquenchable thirst for knowledge means she's a veritable storehouse of facts and figures and bits of gossip, and the influence of Mercury, the ruler of her Sun sign, means she's impelled to pass them on.

Venus' relationships are likely to be made most easily with those with whom she has an intellectual rapport, or those who share her clever wit. She will keep them light, friendly, and on the surface, for she hates to be pinned down or committed in any way. She is an extremely sociable person, and her circle of friends will be large and wide-ranging. She will instinctively know how to adapt herself in order to fit into any social context.

Venus is optimistic, positive and full of crackling energy. She exudes charm, and can be devastatingly witty. She's bright and friendly and - aptly, since Gemini is represented by "the twins" - twice as much fun as anyone else!

Venus' wilfulness



Sun in 9th House

Blessed with the ability to see the 'big picture', Venus' sense of self-identity comes from knowledge and understanding. Venus will seek to establish a wise and philosophical approach to life through which she is able to maintain a sense of personal identity. Highly principled, she has a strong moral code. There will be a burning need to aim for the furthest horizons, and for mental and physical freedom. Born with an incurable wanderlust, she will probably call her piggybank her 'running away fund'!



Sun Sextile Moon

Venus will find self-expression relatively easy which brings a degree of confidence and ease to her personality. Her secret is that she has a positive expectation that life will look after her, and to a large extent she finds this to be true. On the other hand, because life might be quite easy for her and she will probably exhibit a fair degree of laziness, expecting the world to sort everything out with little input from her personally.



Sun Conjunct Venus

Venus will have the ability to express herself in a very elegant manner, which she may well use to great advantage in social situations, particularly as she grows older. She will dislike anything that she sees as ugly or unrefined having a natural desire to aim for sophistication but at the same time she will also have a major tendency for self-indulgence. Cream cakes as a child, partners as an adult. Fortunately, her innate sense of style and grace will always see her through - basically she is, and always will be, a 'charmer'. This will see her through many a tricky situation in life.



Sun Square Saturn

To Venus life seems a bit of a grim affair, she doesn't seem to be able to have fun. She has a natural inclination to see the negative and take things rather seriously. She will be very hard on herself and those who are close to her, expecting high standards. Venus will often feel as though she has too much responsibility and may be prone to bouts of slight depression.

She needs to learn how to inject fun into her life and not take it all so seriously. She'll also probably be a bit of a loner and not have a very strong social life. There is no great harm in this but it is possible that this isolation only reinforces a sense of rejection so any encouragement and warmth shown her will go a long way.



Sun Opposition Neptune

Venus may come across as vague and vacant at times. It's as if she is lost in another world. She has an imagination that needs guidance to make the most of otherwise it becomes just escapism.

Venus is acutely sensitive to the world around her and if that world is full of pain, suffering and conflict she will escape in whatever way she can because Venus finds the suffering of others unbearable and may in some way even feel responsible for it.

Venus needs to learn to be clear and direct and to commit herself to a decision or person. Self-assertion is difficult for her. To avoid confrontation she weaves curious webs to camouflage herself in a fog of confusion. Art, dance and music will use the creative potential locked up here and prevent more destructive conduct.



Sun Trine Pluto

From very early on Venus feels deeply accepted and sure of herself. She knows how to get what she wants out of life through controlling and directing her will. Venus is passionate and feels life intensely but she is also happy to share these feelings with others. She will prove to be powerful and dominant and able to exert a strong influence over others and her environment. She has a unique talent for finding something of value in what others disregard.

The Dominant Parent

In this section we are using traditional astrological rules for defining Venus' relationship with her father. However this may well be more applicable to Venus' Mother. Generally one or other of the parents has the strongest influence in developing Venus' approach to the outside world. Traditionally this has been the father's role but it could perfectly well apply to her Mother, hence the use of the phrase 'The Dominant Parent'.



Cancer in 10th House

Venus could well have a rather ambivalent attitude towards her parents in the sense that the roles of mother and father may not be very clearly defined. Venus will also be very emotionally attached to the whole idea of 'family' and this will no doubt show clearly in later life.



Mercury in 10th House

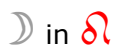
Venus will have a highly communicative relationship with her father, or perhaps her father is just a very talkative and lively minded type. Either way Venus will learn that the way forward in life is through mental power rather than brute strength; flexibility rather than dogged determination; and talking rather than 'doing'.

Emotional and feeling nature

In this section we shall examine how Venus relates on an emotional level. This is traditionally associated with the maternal relationship but we have not made such an obvious assumption and the following section should **not** be read as being primarily concerned with the relationship between mother and child.

Astrologically, the Moon describes our responses, sensitivity, our feeling nature, and the unconscious side of our personality. It shows our emotions and these, of course, will be filtered, or coloured, by the sign in which the Moon falls. Most importantly, the Moon shows our needs.

It shows how we will react on an instinctive level.



Moon in Leo

Venus needs the spotlight, and an audience.

A bit of a 'show-off' as a child and that's an understatement! Venus will seek attention and admiration. She's open in her affections, generous, warm and loving, and just a tiny bit stubborn. She'll have a strong need to love and to be loved in return.

Her main fault is a tendency to become petulant and childish, even when he grows up! if she is ignored, or thwarted in any way. She is naturally creative, with instinctive leadership qualities, and the ability to make people feel 'special'.

Venus will be a delightful child - although she'll expect to be treated like royalty!

The houses of the chart represent different compartments of life, different areas of experience, and each house will 'colour' the Moon in a slightly different way.



Moon in 11th House

This placement confers many friendships, and widespread popularity. Which is just as well, for Venus will have a need for what might seem almost a 'second family' of acquaintances and friends - and the family home may be 'open house' for hordes of people!

Although she may sometimes want to spend time on her own, in general her emotional well-being will be dependent on companionship. So, as she grows up don't be surprised if she uses the telephone more than most children, as she busily 'networks' with all her friends. On another note, as she grows up she is likely to exhibit highly democratic and strong humanitarian ideals. Emotionally, she will need a great deal of 'space'.

Venus' emotions and feelings



Moon Conjunct Jupiter

Venus is emotionally confident, enthusiastic and optimistic; she believes that life will look after her and it usually will. Socially, she will be popular and sought after because she likes a good time and may well be a bit of a joker. Venus is generous and tolerant of others mostly, but needs to be careful of assuming too much and going to extremes. It is likely that she has a very positive and fun relationship with her mother.



Moon Square Uranus

Venus has a unique and original personality; some may even call it perverse or contrary. She demands to 'do her own thing' no matter what; hating any sort of restriction. Her/Her moods will be a little erratic and those close to her may never quite know how she is going to be feeling from one moment to the next, or why! As she grows older she may find 'settling down' in the conventional sense rather difficult.

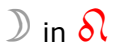


Moon Trine Neptune

Venus will always be a bit of a 'drifter'. She learns from a very early age that the best way to handle life is by being 'loose'. The relationship between her and her mother is extremely empathetic and not in the least restrictive. This bodes well on the whole, but perhaps just a touch more boundary defining would do no harm.

Venus' relationship with her Mother

It is important to understand that the relationship between mother and child is always 'symbiotic'. In other words the way Venus' Mother behaves towards her child and the way Venus perceives her mother is so inextricably linked that it is hard to separate the one from the other. Does Venus' mother react to Venus or does Venus react to her mother? This is perhaps the original chicken and egg question, and in this section we shall try to address this issue.



Moon in Leo

Venus is a loving and joyous child. Both she and her mother have a lot of fun together and she probably considers her to be an utterly delightful child. Venus is a warm and open child who loves to show off - and be shown off - and likes nothing more than to be told how wonderful she is.

The more she is praised, the greater a delight she is. She looks up to her parents and is particularly proud of her mother, just as she is of her. Venus will have a special place in her mother's heart and she will also enjoy all her dramatic way of behaving.




Moon in 11th House

Venus is essentially an extremely social creature and from an early age will look to establish a 'network' of friends and not be confined to the family. Indeed, she will probably prefer to see her family, and especially her mother, as friends rather than parents and siblings. It is also true that her mother prefers the slightly more distant and 'mental' approach herself, not wishing to be cast in the traditional 'mum' role. This relationship will encourage Venus to be highly independent and to stand on her own two feet from an early age.

Personality

This section looks at how Venus views the world and likes to be viewed by others. No matter what Venus' essential nature may be all of us have a 'face' that we put on for public consumption and this section describes that 'face'.

AS in 

Venus' ascendant/rising sign is Libra

Venus is the chart ruler of those born with Libra rising, and because of Venus's beneficial nature, Venus will probably be fortunate enough to sail through adolescence without suffering the social agony of acne! Moreover, she may also be blessed with Venus's gift of dimples!

Venus will be a likeable and agreeable child. She will make many friends and her popularity at school will probably be high. She will be eager to earn the good opinion of her teachers, and is likely to be a well-behaved and fairly conformist pupil. Creative, and with an eye for beauty, she should do well in Art classes, and enjoy the thrust and parry of the Debating Society.

She may display a somewhat indolent side to her nature which, when she is older, will consolidate into an easy, unhurried manner.

One of the strongest features of a Libra ascendant, it would be unreasonable to consider it a 'fault', is the trait of 'running with the hare and hunting with the hounds'.

Because of her conciliatory nature, Venus is likely to consider that 'Discretion should be the better part of valor'. For her, upholding her principles may be less important than retaining the regard and goodwill of those she's involved with. Because she cannot cope with what she perceives as the ugliness of confrontation, she may settle for second best in the cause of establishing peace and harmony. 'Anything for a quiet life' will be a favourite motto. 'Don't rock the boat' will be another.

This characteristic, however, could be positively made use of in Venus' career if she were involved in the fields of, say, diplomacy, mediation, advising or public relations.

'Charm' is a word that will always be associated with Venus. Her pleasant and easy-going manner, her happy facility for making friends and her extreme sociability, will all combine to make her universally liked.



Pluto in 1st House

No matter how Venus likes to portray herself there is an incredibly strong streak of determination hidden not far beneath the surface.

As a child she will be prove difficult to control having a will of iron that is a little more than mere stubbornness. This determination will prove very useful in later life and no doubt she will be very successful but it might be a little too much for a child to handle at times. Venus will need to be encouraged to develop a stronger sense of empathy and not regard everyone else around her as simply vassals.

Essentially Venus is driven in many ways by irrational fear that is then over-compensated for. So as a child she will fear maternal rejection and become demanding and manipulative. As she grows older she will acquire money to avoid the fear of poverty, and so on. Once this is understood it is possible to alleviate the fear with a judicious mix of defined boundaries and a bucket-full of love and reassurance.

Section B

Toddler to teenager the process of development

Assertion

In this section we will be looking at the way in which Venus finds her way through the rough and tumble of childhood and later life, without being pushed around by others. The methods and approaches she uses to make sure her own needs are met and how she deals with the needs of others when they are at odds with her own.



Mars in 12th House

Venus is a difficult one to call. On the surface she is rarely given to outbursts of temper and others may regard her as a bit of a shrinking violet. On the other hand, once in a while she blows up and there appears almost no limit to her anger. There also may appear to be little reason for such an immense outburst. In the murky depths of the ocean it is sometimes difficult to fathom causes and connections!

Friends and social groups

In this section we shall be looking at what sort of friends Venus needs and what she is likely to bring to friendships herself. We shall also look at the way in which she is likely to interact with social groups or whether, for example, she would prefer to be on her own.



Leo in 11th House

Venus will be extremely social by nature but she may choose her friends in order that they will look up to her. She will not be essentially democratic but try to be the leader in any social group. This could be very positive but also has a potentially negative side that it would be wise to guard against.



Moon in 11th House

Venus has quite an open nature and can make friends fairly easily. She will also like to have her friends come home. At the same time, Venus may well be easily hurt and it might be wise for her to learn that things are often not as personal as she believes them to be.



Jupiter in 11th House

Socially, Venus likes to be associated with people whom she perceives as educated or philosophical - occasionally simply clowns. She is generous to her friends and, although she likes to think she is essentially democratic and fair to all, in truth she might be quite judgmental and even, on occasion, slightly snobbish.

Uranus in 2nd House

Venus will have an exciting social life, and being a member of a group or club will give her a sense of security and stability. She may pursue money with great energy, largely because she will enjoy the freedom it brings. In her adult years, she will always be successful at being able to extricate herself from financial scrapes in the most ingenious of ways.

The power of the mind

In this section we indicate Venus' communication and learning skills, her needs at school and requirements for her further education. Of particular interest to her parents will be how to talk and connect with her.



Sagittarius in 3rd House

No matter how short the time Venus may spend in the school system, she is one of life's natural students and will never stop learning. She has a curious mind, and many far-ranging interests. Dull facts and figures may bore her, but once her vivid imagination is fired, she will throw herself enthusiastically into expanding her store of knowledge. In turn, she loves to share her knowledge, and would make an excellent and inspirational teacher. She is a skilled storyteller and image-weaver.



Neptune in 3rd House

This child may hide her ideas and thoughts from those around her, making it difficult for others to get to know what she is really thinking. Her mind can be swamped by feelings and emotions as there is no hard logic in her thinking, she is often confused by her muddled thoughts and this can make her feel vulnerable and unhappy.

But she is more than compensated by a rich and creative imagination that enables her to live on a different mental plane from the rest of us.

Pretence is as good as reality to her. She may invent fantasy situations and scenarios, and her world is likely to be peopled with imaginary friends who have sprung from her fertile mind. And woe betide anyone who fails to pay proper respect to the invisible chum or who forgets to set a place for the invented child when laying the table for tea! Such imaginary friends, however, often fade, mercifully for the parents! into the background once school is started with its 'flesh and blood' attractions.

Academically, Venus is likely to be a daydreamer, who is frequently chastised for gazing out of the window when she should be attending to her studies. In spite of this, she'll still manage to learn by a form of 'intellectual osmosis' - picking up vibrations and translating them into knowledge. Such a system though, may well not be appreciated by Venus' teachers, who may consider her irritatingly vague and lacking in concentration.

Although her school reports may disapprove of her for not paying attention in many of her lessons, her English teacher is likely to find her highly intelligent and extremely responsive. Books, words, poetry and art will inspire her, and help her make the most of her not inconsiderable talents. She could display real promise in drama classes, for instance, and she may have a flair for creative writing.

Mercury in Cancer

There is a shy and sensitive side to Venus' nature, despite what may be apparent on the surface. Subtle nuances and undercurrents in the family and home environment are picked up and absorbed by her, and she is likely to be unusually close to her mother, mirroring her outlook and attitudes.

By no stretch of the imagination could Venus be called a 'chatterbox', although she is far more talkative when in the security of her home than outside, but she can effectively communicate her feelings through moods and responses.

She may be quite emotional as a child, seeking reassurance from her family and her mother in particular, so hugs and cuddles will be far more effective in soothing her than words. Leaving the security of her family when she first starts school may be particularly scary, and a special plaything or toy tucked inside her school bag will do much to comfort her!

Mercury in 10th House

Venus is likely to be every teacher's dream - a child with a fine appreciation of the role that education can play in the furtherance of career issues.

Because of this awareness, she will put time and effort into her studies. She may be a slow learner, but she is concerned to get things right and so won't be hurried. Slow and steady is her motto.

Venus is very good at keeping her own counsel, so it may go unnoticed that she has a very strong need to be appreciated as an educated and clever person. She also needs the assurance of tangible proof of her intellectual achievements, and examination certificates and diplomas will be hung on her wall with pride.

The seeds of ambition will be sown at an early age, and throughout the years Venus will be quietly working to a master plan that will culminate in status, prestige, and the respect of others. She is able to communicate easily with those in authority and positions of power, and this astrological placement of Mercury lends an air of gravity to what she has to say.

Venus has a sharp and incisive mind that gets to the point quickly. She 'cottons on' rapidly when learning something new but, because learning comes easily to her, she may be impatient of slower folk.

This will lead to boredom, tempting her to switch off from her lessons and think about something else. Her mind works well with games of strategy, like chess.

Mercury Sextile Saturn

Mentally disciplined, Venus is able to use her logical and practical mind to plan constructively and shape her thinking. Academically, she is not afraid of hard work; her preparation is thorough; and she is ready to do what may be necessary to achieve success.

Earning and spending money

In this section we shall look at how Venus is likely to develop in terms of her attitude towards the acquisition and expenditure of money.



Scorpio in 2nd House

Venus is very resourceful when it comes to making money. To her, it represents power, and so she will strive to make a great deal of it. She does nothing by half-measures, and so has the potential to amass a large amount of money during her working life.



Uranus in 2nd House

In the big, wide world there are bills to be paid and financial obligations to be met and there's no escaping them. And Venus' finances are likely to be subject to wild fluctuation at the best of times.

But she will develop a singular talent for improvising, and for spotting potentially beneficial openings. Her original and inventive approach to money making will invariably work to her advantage.

She will be very relaxed about borrowing from or lending cash to her friends, and is likely to display a very 'laid-back' attitude to money.

Venus in Gemini

Venus is likely to be very versatile in how she likes to earn her money. She may even hold down two jobs at once, or follow more than one career path in her life. The charm of her personality invariably plays a part in how she earns her living.

Finding that she attracts money fairly easily, it is also in her nature to spend it freely on whatever takes her fancy.



Venus in 9th House

Venus is unlikely to be overly concerned with personal financial gain in the sense of acquisitiveness. On the other hand she will always have a strong appreciation for, and need of, money for the freedom it brings her to pursue her own interests.

Section C - preparing for independence

Higher education and establishing values

In this section we shall examine how Venus is likely to find her place in society, as she grows older. What standards she will set for herself and what she values. This will probably not become clear until Venus has reached at least the puberty stage.



Gemini in 9th House

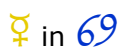
